CURBSIDE RECYCLING REMINDERS:

- City ordinance provides for curbside **recycling** to all residents living in single family homes.
- Haulers must provide curbside collection of **recyclables** at least once a week **at no extra charge**.
- Some solid waste haulers provide **recycling** carts or totes to residents, or you can use your own, which is why the City provides **FREE recycling** stickers (see below).
- You can put all of your **recyclables** into the same cart or tote — no need to sort anything!
- **Your solid waste hauler must accept all of the following items:**
 - Plastic food & beverage containers labeled #1-#7 (except #6 Styrofoam)
 - Cardboard & boxboard (flattened)
 - Paper towel & toilet paper rolls
 - The clean portion of a pizza box
 - Paperback books & telephone books
 - Magazines, newspapers, inserts, & residential mixed paper (staples are ok!)
 - Aluminum & metal food cans, foil trays (rinsed out), empty aerosol cans
 - Glass food & beverage containers (rinsed out)



Please do not leave your recyclables out in the rain or wind. It's also best to use a cart or tote with a **LID!**

Please make sure your recyclables are **EMPTY, CLEAN, & DRY!**

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING:

There will be two Residential Electronics Collection events in 2018:

- **May 19, 2018** (online registration opens April 9)
- **Oct 13, 2018** (online registration opens Sept 10)

There are many local recyclers that will accept most of your old electronics for drop off throughout the year. Visit the City's recycling webpage for more information: champaignil.gov/recycling

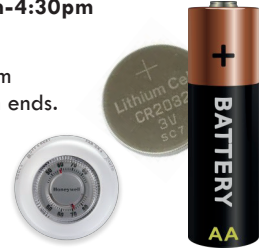
BATTERY RECYCLING:

There is now a battery recycling drop-off bin at **Champaign Public Works, 702 Edgebrook Drive**. Lobby hours: Mon-Fri, 7:30am-4:30pm

Household quantities only.

Rechargeable batteries & lithium batteries must be taped at both ends. Alkaline (single-use) batteries do not need to be taped.

We also accept old mercury thermostats & thermometers.



The City offers **FREE RECYCLING STICKERS** for your outdoor/indoor carts or totes!



The City offers **FREE 5-GALLON INDOOR BUCKETS** for your recyclables!

Collect recyclables in your kitchen, bathroom, or whatever room that works for you, and then toss the recyclables into your outdoor cart or tote!

Want to recycle Styrofoam but don't know how or where? **Dart Corporation, 1505 E. Main St., Urbana**, now has an easy-to-use Styrofoam drop-off center in their parking lot (off Lierman Ave.)
