## 10 RECYCLING TIPS TO HELP MAKE DETROIT CLEANER AND GREENER

1. Remember the four basic recyclables:

- Aluminum and steel cans
- Newspaper, cardboard and office paper
- Plastics (#1-7)
- Glass bottles and jars



2. Place all recyclables loose in the recycling cart, and always have your cart out by 7 a.m. on your service day.

3. All items must be in the cart to be collected. Do not place recyclables on top of or around your cart.

4. Plastic bags are not accepted.

5. Take-out containers and donut boxes are not recyclable.

6. Polystyrene (Styrofoam) is not accepted.

7. Empty and rinse out all containers before recycling.

8. Paint, automotive fluids, car batteries and pesticides cannot be accepted and should be disposed of at the Household Hazardous Waste Receiving Facility at 2000 E. Ferry Street (near the I-75 and I-94 freeways).

9. Do not place yard waste in your recycling cart.

10. When in doubt, throw it out (in the garbage).
